Rebates are available on a case-by-case basis. Rebates are based on kW reduction on retrofit projects only. \$50/KW saved, rebate cannot exceed 25% of project cost and a minimum of 1KW and maximum of \$4,000. Call our office and ask for our electrician or go to our website to get the rebate calculator to see if you qualify. A check will be issued.


According to the U.S. Energy Information Administration, Minnesota's average price for residential electricity remains lower than the national average.

For the average Minnesotan household, which uses 25 kilowatthours per day according to data from the Environmental Protection Agency, electricity costs equal about \$3 per day. ELECTRICITY REMAINS A GOOD VALUE


