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#### **CROCKPOT ANGEL CHICKEN**

#### **Ingredient:**

1.5 pounds chicken breast boneless and skinless

3 cloves garlic chopped or left whole

10.5 ounces cream of chicken soup

3/4 cup chicken stock

1/4 cup cream cheese

1/4 cup butter

0.6 ounces Italian dressing mix (Ex. Good Seasons)

1 pound angel hair pasta

#### Instructions:

- 1. Spray the inside of the crockpot with non stick cooking spray.
- 2. Add the chicken breast.
- 3. Add the garlic.
- 4. Soften the butter and cream cheese in the microwave.
- 5. Whisk until smooth.
- 6. Whisk in the cream of chicken soup (don't dilute it)
- 7. Add the Italian dressing mix and the chicken stock.
- 8. Whisk until well mixed.
- 9. Pour over the chicken breasts.
- 10. Cover and cook on low for 6 to 8 hours.
- 11. Just before chicken is done cook the angel hair past. Drain.
- 12. Serve the chicken over the pasta.
